

Secure Online Access to Aggregated Patient Data

Patient Data Browser (PDB) aggregates patient information from disparate legacy systems and applications into a unified record based on the user's role and authorization to access specific patient information. It enables hospitals to provide remote access to information at the same time that it limits what is viewed to only the data that is authorized for specific users. It substantially decreases paper flow between organizations, improves productivity, and increases user satisfaction.
